"Beta" - Down-style, taiko is placed on ground and hit perpedicularly. Most basic style of taiko.
 "Shime Daiko" - Smaller roped drum with high pitch. Often used to keep the basebeat for ensemble drumming.
 "Jiuchi" - Basebeat to keep ensemble together
 "SNOB" - Shime, Naname, Odaiko, Beta Drilling and Fundamentals class.
 "Odaiko" - Literally "Big Drum," the class will use the biggest drums in the facility in a style that faces the drum directly.
